Job Purpose Summary	The Finance Assistant will work as part of the charity finance team to help ensure the integrity of financial records. The Finance Assistant ensures the correct processing and recording of the charity's financial transactions for the UK.

Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities

Core Responsibilities

- Record in QuickBooks all USD and GBP bank, MoneyCorp and PayPal entries
- Reconcile all USD and GBP bank accounts, MoneyCorp account and PayPal account on a monthly basis
- Review supplier invoices and expense claims, collate supporting documents, obtain appropriate authorisations, enter into QuickBooks and set up bank payments for UK suppliers and staff
- Set up multi-currency payments for other countries and ensure country creditors ledgers are kept up-to-date
- Responsible for maintaining the UK debtors and creditors ledgers
- Record in QuickBooks corporate credit card transactions with supporting documents and appropriate authorisations secured
- Reconcile specified balance sheet accounts on a monthly basis (mostly but not limited to bank, Funds In Transit, debtors and creditors)
- Assist with preparing audit schedules (mostly but not limited to schedules relating to bank, Funds In Transit, debtors and creditors)
- Any other tasks as required

- Excellent organisational skills and attention to detail, flexible and able to work remotely and independently

This role is based in the UK, with existing UK Right to Work required, and is offered as a part-time (0.4 FTE / 15 hours per week) position for an initial fixed-term period of 6 months (with the possibility that this will be extended). Remuneration is circa £30,000 per year (pro rata to £12,000) per annum, depending on experience.
