Background

In Myanmar, Turquoise Mountain is active across built heritage restoration in downtown Yangon, supporting and reviving the traditional craft industries across the country, and arts education. Bringing its decade-long experience in connecting artisans to international markets, Turquoise Mountain has also set up a local social enterprise called Myanmar Artisans Limited, which is committed to preserving and promoting Myanmar's rich craft traditions, and securing livelihoods for artisans. We are currently establishing a Myanmar Cultural Centre in Yangon, a hub for art, design, and craft from Myanmar with a strong focus on public outreach and arts education. The Centre will also include a showroom that brings the best of Myanmar craftmanship to market.

Main Responsibilities

- Showroom outfitting: arrange stock in a manner that is both visually appealing and allows ease of movement.
- Ensure all products are labelled and priced correctly.
- Retail partnerships: establish commercial relationships with like-minded retailers to include their products in our showroom on a commission basis.
- Stock management: monitor and manage inventory levels and order new items where required.
- Showroom administration: manage store budgets and update financial records (with support from the Financial Manager)
- Local retail sales and walk-in clients: deliver excellent service to ensure a high level of customer satisfaction.
- Respond to customer complaints and concerns in a timely and professional manner.
- With the Commercial Manager's support, develop and arrange promotional material and instore displays.
- Prepare reports on buying trends, customer traffic, and customer feedback.
- With support from the Commercial Manager, develop strategies to attract new customers and increase store traffic. This can include promotions, in-store events, launch of new collections, social media advertising, and so on.
- Local sales events: lead on Turquoise Mountain's participation in local sales events, for example, pop-up stalls at markets or events.
