## TERMS OF REFERENCE

### Technical Drawing Trainer

#### Background

Turquoise Mountain is a non-profit, non-governmental organization specializing in heritage based urban regeneration, traditional craft-training and connecting artisans to market opportunities. We seek to provide jobs, skills, and a sense of pride, through heritage. Since 2006 Turquoise Mountain has restored 150 historic and community buildings, trained 10,000 craftspeople, generated direct sales of \$7m in craft products and welcomed 1m visitors to our exhibitions worldwide.

#### Context

Turquoise mountain runs both entry-level and more advanced apprenticeship programmes across a range of traditional crafts, including woodwork, stone-carving, embroidery, and jewellery. The courses are open to both refugees and host community members at Turquoise Mountain's training centres in Jabal Amman and in northern Amman.

The purpose of this part-time role is to Provide technical drawing lessons to entry level woodwork trainees that will be delivered in parallel to their technical woodwork training and design training.

#### Roles and Responsibilities

- Deliver training to 15 entry level woodworking trainees that focuses on the basics of technical drawing
- Support the trainees in the production of technical drawings for their graduation projects in coordination with the woodwork trainers, design trainers and design team and in line with Turquoise Mountain woodwork curriculum
- Provide Mentorships and feedback to the trainees through weekly assignments.

#### Skills:

- A minimum of 5 years experience in architecture or product design.
- Experience in technical drawing.
- Previous experience in training.
- Good interpersonal skills with patience and flexibility.
- Experience in crafts and cultural Heritage is desirable.
